

Main Character: Mr. 4.0 and his conscious . Mr. 4.0 can only “see” his conscious in certain situations. Conscious main role is to be a narrator for the story.

Ideas:

1. Use conscious to narrate story to make up for lack of a microphone.
2. Use clocks and watches to show time elapse.

Scene 1: Introduce narrative style. Narrator is the “conscious” of Mr. 4.0. He is in class not really paying attention because he thinks the class is boring and too easy. His conscious pops in and asks him why he really isn’t paying attention. Leaves class only to find out there is a test.

- - Scene begins in classroom. Mr. 4.0 learns that he has an upcoming test as he leaves the class.
- - use Charlie Brown teach voice over when teacher speaks.
- - Shows Mr 4.0 not paying attention. Texting, on Facebook, playing Candy Crush, sleeping.
- - Camera will rotate between Mr 4.0 not paying attention, his teacher and the white board, and the clock.
- - Class starts at noon and ends at 1pm. Will put camera on the clock to show time lapse. Will need to find a clock that can manually be adjusted.
- - Teacher will be always filmed from the neck down but uses hand expressions and body language.
- -Narrator speaks while Mr. 4.0 says nothing

Scene 2: Leaving class, Mr 4.0 walks around Emory to head home. Narrator discussing upcoming goals for Mr 4.0. Mr. 4.0 eventually walks off with the narrator and tells him that he would study tonight.

- scene probably be on the quad with Mr 4.0 walking towards the camera while his conscious narrates .
- learning about the underlying Mr 4.0 goals and motivations the internship. Can be holding a printed page about the internship and camera will focus on the paper once he walks close to the camera.
- conscious eventually join him on the screen and walks with him.

Scene 3: Mr 4.0 gets home and turns on the Xbox and starts playing music. His conscious interrupts the scene and asks him why isn’t he studying for his test.

- Scene freezes, narrator points out to audience that Mr. 4.0 is not studying
- Narrator becomes part of the scene and asks Mr. 4.0 why he isn’t studying

Scene 4: Mr 4.0 eventually begins to study Scene shows Mr. 4.0 pulling out his book and notes and begins studying in his living room. He falls asleep and his conscious wakes him up before he misses his test.

- Not much dialog for the scene.

Scene 6: Shows Mr. 4.0 waking up from sleeping on his book. He looks around and notices things are a little out of place. Even have a couple cans of beer on his table that he falls asleep on. He doesn't think much of it and heads to class.

Scene 7: Is him taking the test and a time elapse till him getting the test back.

- Takes the test but finishes in 15 minutes while everybody else is still working hard.
- Feels he did very well but when he gets the test back, he failed it.
- Questions if the test was correctly graded bc he has never failed a test.
- Finds out he has another test next week

Scene 8: gets home and receives a call from his mom. Conversation is overly dramatic. Mr. 4.0 explains how he has failed his first test and he doesn't even know if he is meant for college anymore. Mom gives him the pep talk but even then that only half way motivates him.

- In Mr. 4.0 living room. at a table. Mr 4.0 will have conversation on speaker phone and hopefully the mic from the camera will catch it. If not, give mom a charlie brown voice over and have Mr. 4.0 respond in a way that you could guess the question the Mom would be asking.

Scene 9: Mr. 4.0 is a little down on himself sitting in the living room. The night before his next test. His conscious comes to the scene. Mr 4.0 tells him how he studied and still failed the test and his conscious flashback to the night and shows that Mr. 4.0 didn't really study. He did open book and read some of it but was distracted by other things such as friends, tv, facebook and even had a few drinks. Mr 4.0 tries to study again.

- Find out that Mr. 4.0 needs a A to get a highly regarded internship

Scene 10. Mr. 4.0 takes test two and gets grade.

- Finishes his test in 15 minutes again. Camera moves to a clock to emphasis that he finished both test in 15 minutes.
- Just when he gets up, he decides to double check his answers to make sure they are right.
- Camera shows that its 1:05 pm and Mr. 4.0 finally turns in his test. Class is from 12 to 1.
- Show a clock that spins 24 hours and then Mr 4.0 getting A +

If time

Scene 11: Excited, he rushes home to apply to internship to only find out even with good grades he wasn't selected:

- Mr.4.0 frantically rushes to his computer, see him filing out a form
- Camera on clock to show time elapse of a week
- Receives rejection letter

Scene 12: Mr. 4.0 is on the couch. A little bummed that he did not get the internship. His

conscious comes into the scene. They converse and the conscious eventually leaves the scene that is when Mr. 4.0 phone rings. He finds out that his professor was so impressed with his improvement that he recommended him for another highly competitive internship and that internship is calling to tell him that he has been accepted.

- Quick discussion between the two.
- Conscious leaves scene telling Mr. 4.0 hard work always pays off.
- Camera cuts to his phone ringing. Mr 4.0 doesn't recognize the number and doesn't really feel like talking. Nevertheless he reluctantly answers anyways.

Moral of the story. Mr. 4.0 learned that in life there are a lot more No's than yes's but don't harp on the all the No's you receive bc the few yes's you receive can really make your day.
